She completed her training in Endocrinology at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Harvard Medical School, Boston, MA, USA.

Assist. Prof. Paschou has published a large number of chapters in prestigious scientific books, such as Oxford Textbook of Endocrinology and Diabetes, and papers in prestigious scientific journals, such as New England Journal of Medicine. Her main areas of interest are Diabetes/Obesity/Metabolism, Reproductive Endocrinology and Thyroid. Her author metrics can be summarized as following: publications in PubMed 177, citations 4,135, h-index 31, i10-index 82. Expertscape's PubMed-based algorithms place Assist. Prof. Paschou in the top 0.1% of scholars writing about Diabetes Mellitus over the past 10 years, a level labeled as "World Expert". Assist.
